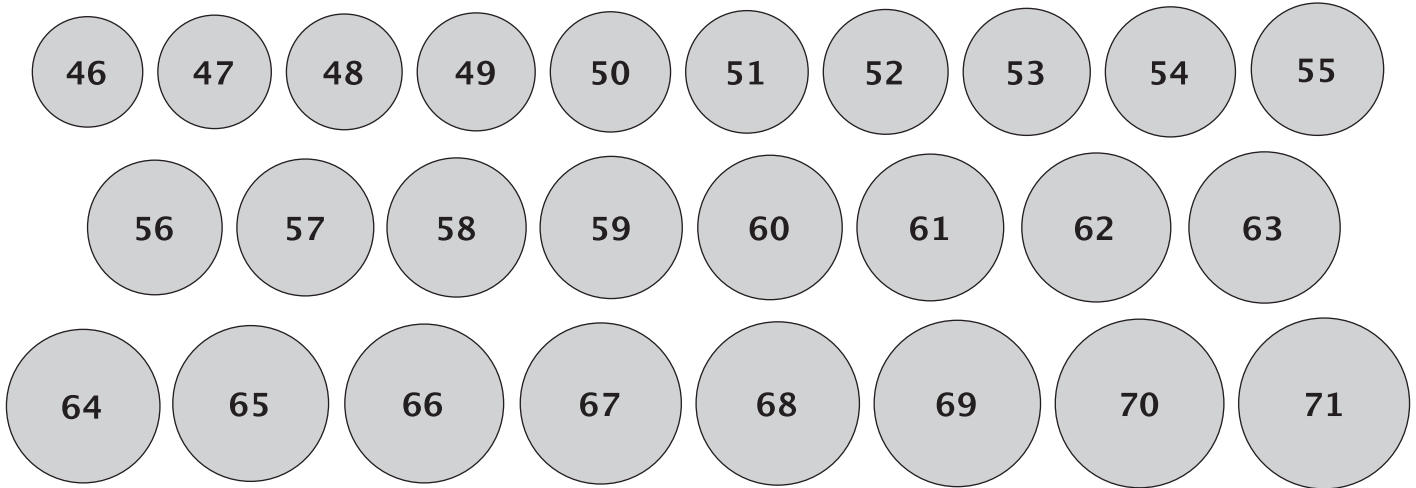


DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE.

Don't have a ring yet? Cut out the measuring tool above and determine your ring size by fitting it around your finger. Compare your letter from the size guide with the corresponding ring size.

Already have a ring? Use the circles below or a ruler/caliper to determine your ring size.

Place your ring on a circle; you should not see any white edge around the black.

How to measure ring size:

Place a well-fitting ring of your own or the person for whom you are buying a ring on the circles above.

The edge of the circle should align with the inside of the ring.

Prefer using a *ruler*? Measure the inside of your ring with the ruler and check which diameter in mm corresponds to the ring size.

Tip:

Planning to purchase a wide ring? Then choose a ring size that is half to a whole size larger than your normal ring size.

Wider rings tend to feel tighter around your finger.



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Check the scale of your print here:
